**Terms and Conditions**

1. Headwaters Livestock, Montana State University, Equine Boosters of MSU and its associates and employees act as agents only on all sales, and are not responsible for buyer/seller error or misunderstanding.
2. Consignment forms **MUST** be accompanied by the consignment fee of \$100.00, original registration papers, signed transfer, breeders certificates (if applicable), and quality color photographs. **The consignment/catalogue deadline is March 18, 2009 at 5:00 PM (no exceptions).**
3. All horses **MUST** be broke to ride.
4. Individual **NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST** (original, not copy) current within 6 months and a Health Certificate within **72 hours of arrival** at our establishment must be turned into the sales office when consignments arrive. No horses may unload on site until all Coggins tests and health certificates have been checked. All paperwork must be turned into office prior to sale.
5. Horses with any unsoundness or bad habits (Example: Cribbers, Parrot Mouth, Lameness or Unsoundness, etc.) are not eligible for entry in the sale. If there is any question MSU veterinarians will make the final judgment and be dismissed from the sale.
6. Consignors' checks will be mailed after 5-7 business days from the date of the sale.
7. Consignment/Catalogue fee will be \$100.00 and commission is 7% of the selling price. No Sales or Pass Outs must be stated before the horse leaves the ring. Pass out fee is **\$50.00 or 3 ½ percent** of the final bid whichever is greater. In compliance with our insurance fee (.07 percent of \$100.00 in gross sales) will be assessed as well as a \$3.00 vet inspection fee. **NO Paper work will be given back until all NO SALE FEES and CATALOG FEES are paid. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
8. The consignment fee **is non-refundable**. Consignor agrees not to withdraw entry except for injury, sickness, or death. Consignor must provide the sales company with a statement from licensed vet prior from the date of sale to withdraw. Consignors withdrawing a horse for any reason other than those listed above will be assessed a \$200.00 penalty to cover advertising and sales expenses. **No alley trading will be allowed.**
9. Transfer fees will be deducted from the sellers check in the case of the double transfers.
10. Horses will be stalled at the MSU Miller Livestock Pavilion in outdoor pens. If you would prefer an indoor stall, please contact the Gallatin County Fairgrounds at: 406-582-3270. Any problems please call Misty Radue Horse Sale Manager 406-539-1229.
